
Mounts of the Bible

- 3. Abimelech went up to this Mount and cut down a tree bough, those with him did the same, then used this wood to burn the tower of Shechem.
- 6. The Edomites, descendents of Esau, dwelt on this Mount.
- 8. This brother of Moses died on Mount Hor in the 40th year after the children of Israel came out of Egypt.
- 10. This Mount was also known as Kirjath Jearim.
- 14. In Numbers, chapter 33, Israel moved from this place to camp at Mount Shepher.
- 18. Before Moses died, he went up to this Mount and the LORD showed him the land of Israel's inheritance.

- 1. The name of this Mount is considered by most an alternate name for Sinai.
- Solomon built the house of the LORD on this Mount.
- 4. When the floods receeded, the ark rested on this Mount.
- 5. This Mount represents the farthest south conquest of Joshua and the Israelites.
- 7. The tribes of Reuben, Gad, Asher, Zebulun, Dan, and Naphtali stood on this Mount to rehearse curses for disobedience to the LORD.
- 9. Referred to as a Mount in Deuteronomy and Habbakuk, this is a mountain range forming the northern boundary of the desert of Sinai.

- 20. From this Mount king Abijah of Judah declared God was with Judah, and the LORD delivered Jereboam's army, twice the size of his, into his hands.
- 21. This Mount was the site of the Jebusite fortress that was conquered by King David.
- Chesalon, a city on the northern boundary of Judah, was on this Mount.
- 23. When his feet stand on the Mount of Olives, the Mount shall split apart.
- The tribes of Simeon, Levi, Judah, Issachar, Joseph, and Benjamin stood on this Mount to rehearse blessings for obedience to the LORD.
- 26. The LORD God spoke the Ten Commandments from this Mount.
- This judge of Israel directed Barak and ten thousand men to descend from Mount Tabor and attack Sisera.
- This mountain range hosts it's highest point, Mount Nebo.
- Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal on this Mount.
- 30. He was buried on the north side of Mount Gaash, having lived 110 years.

Down

- Five lords of the Philistines, Canaanites, Sidonians, and Hivites dwelt on this Mount, left there by the LORD to test Israel's obedience to God.
- 12. The snow melt from this Mount was a significant source of water for Israel.
- 13. The "Mount of Corruption" was a name attributed to part of the Mount of Olives because idol temples were erected there under the reign of this king of Israel.
- The Amorites could not be driven from this Mount but eventually came under tribute to the house of Joseph.
- Meaning "Mount of Breaches", this location is believed to be where David defeated the Philistines.
- Omri, king of Israel, built upon the hill of Shemer, from whence this Mount's name is derived.
- 19. On Mount Gilead the LORD selected 300 men to help this judge of Israel defeat the Midianites.
- 22. The "cities of Mount Ephron" formed one of the landmarks on the northern boundary of this particular tribe of Israel.
- 24. From Jeremiah 31, on this Mount the watchmen will cry, "Arise, and let us go up to Zion, To the LORD our God."
- 25. King Saul died in battle on this Mount.
